#### 1.0 Recommendations for decision/noting:

It is recommended that the Boundary Review Committee:-

- 1.1 Notes the Returning Officer's proposals for revised polling places, polling districts and polling stations as set out in this report at Appendix 1 and to approve commencement of public consultation on these proposals, closing on 25 November 2022.
- 1.2 Notes the proposals for consultation set out in sections 3.5 to 3.7 of this report; and
- 1.3 Delegates authority to the Director: Policy & Governance to take all necessary steps to conclude the review prior to a further report being brought to the Committee for approval on 28 November 2022.

## **2.0 Purpose of Report**

- 2.1 To review polling places, polling districts and polling stations following the Borough boundary review completed undertaken this year by the LGBCE.

## **3.0 Background**

- 3.1 The Borough's new ward boundaries will come in to force at the Borough and Parish elections on 4 May 2023.
- 3.2 The changes to the existing ward boundaries are the result of the recent review of the Borough's electoral arrangements by the Local Government Boundary Commission for England (LGBCE). That review made final proposals for the Borough to retain 54 councillors made up of 32 wards (an increase from the current 30 wards). This consists of 5 three councillor wards, 12 two councillor wards and 15 one councillor wards. The boundaries of most existing wards were changed. The review also made recommendations for changes to the warding arrangements for a number of Parish/Town councils as a result of the revised Borough boundaries. LGBCE final recommendations can be found here at their website, which is linked in the background papers section of this report.
- 3.3 In preparation for the new ward boundaries coming in to effect it is necessary that an interim review be undertaken. This is a review of polling districts, the sub areas into which each ward is divided and also the polling places, the buildings in which polling stations are located. The last statutory review took place in 2019. The procedure for a review is laid down in the Representation of the People Act 1983. The Act lays down how reviews should be approached. The review should ensure that all electors shall have as reasonable facilities for voting as practicable and that all polling places should be accessible by electors with disabilities. Every Parish should be in its own polling district and a polling place should be designated for each polling district.
- 3.4 The Council is fortunate that most of its polling stations are well established and meet the Electoral Commission's guidelines for polling stations. Due to the ongoing support from the wider community the Council only uses a small number of temporary portacabin style buildings and also uses a very small number of schools.
- 3.5 The consultation period runs up to 25 November 2022. Ward and polling district maps and a Borough wide map will be provided on the Council's website to assist residents in identifying their proposed polling station. To assist with consultation, the support of the Council's engagement team has been sought in order to reach out to a wider audience. In addition, officers will work with representatives from the Council's Making it Real Board to look at polling station accessibility for residents and in particular access for people with disabilities.
- 3.6 Copies of the proposals will be deposited at Addenbrooke House and Southwater, inviting responses to be made.

## 4.0 Summary of main proposals

4.1 In view of the wide ranging changes made by LGBCE a number of electors will vote in different wards on 4 May 2023. A number of electors may also vote by voting at a different polling station, dependent on the outcome of this review. A number of polling districts have been merged following boundary changes whilst some polling districts have been split to accommodate changes and warding of Parish areas. Affected electors will be notified of any change to their polling station on their polling cards prior to elections in May. The Returning Officer's proposals for each ward are shown below. A3 detailed maps will be provided at the meeting.

### Admaston & Bratton

Electors move in to the ward from the Crowdale road area of the Shawbirch (WSH) ward. A new polling district (WAB) is required for these electors who will vote in Admaston & Bratton borough ward and the Meadows ward of Wellington Town Council. It is proposed that they continue to vote at Admaston Community Centre
