

Garden design

1 Vegetable garden
To include a green house, shed and raised planters. Provides a opportunity for residents to engage in familiar activities which can trigger memory associations and encourage independence.

2 Drying areas

Activities such as hanging laundry again can trigger memories and become a social activity.

3 Covered timber pergolas Social areas for residents

4 Lower patio area To include BBQ, picnic tables & benches

5 **Upper patio area** To include seating

6 Woodland seating area

To include seating and water feature.
A variety of seating areas can offer a
quiet space for residents to relax and
ease stress/anxiety.

7 Retained woodland area

Trees to be coppiced & area routinely maintained.

Enclosed area for additional plant/external storage

9 Roof terrace

Accessible from both clusters and staff hub. For use by both residents and staff.

10 Maintenance access

To the side of the building

11 Retained trees

Along perimeter

12 Smoking shelter

13 Sensory planting

Low maintenance. native species.
Variety of colours, textures and strong scented plants to provide sensory stimuli for residents.

Wheelchair accessible ramp To access upper garden/patio

15 Protective guarding to retaining features

To prevent falls from height
