“Our Council is a ‘corporate parent’ to over 400 children and young people in care across Telford and Wrekin.

“The borough-wide Corporate Parenting Strategy for the next three years is central to our vision to achieve the best possible outcomes for our children in care and care leavers. We are on their side, we want to help them thrive, exceed their potential and expand their life chances.

“The voices of children in care and care leavers are at the very heart of this strategy, to ensure their views and the ongoing dialogue with them shape the priorities and decision making for us as Corporate Parents.

“As such, children in care and care leavers have identified seven priorities that have become our priorities as Corporate Parents. For each priority, we have identified key actions (“We Will”) and success criteria (“How we know we have made a difference”).
