Notice is hereby given that at its meeting on 19 September 2019 the Authority agreed to adopt a new Members' Allowances Scheme for the municipal year 2019-2020. In determining the Scheme, the Authority complied with its duty to have regard to the recommendations of the Independent Remuneration Panel, all of which it accepted. The main provisions of the scheme are summarised below. The Basic Allowance will apply from 7 May 2019 and Special Responsibility Allowances will apply from 24 May 2019.
